34 12 \$34,200,400 is allocated as the statewide expenditure target
34 13 under section 232.143 for group foster care maintenance and
34 14 services. If the department projects that such expenditures
34 15 for the fiscal year will be less than the target amount
34 16 allocated in this lettered paragraph, the department may
34 17 reallocate the excess to provide additional funding for
34 18 shelter care or the child welfare emergency services addressed
34 19 with the allocation for shelter care.

35 13 7. Notwithstanding section 234.35 or any other provision
35 14 of law to the contrary, state funding for shelter care shall

35 15 be limited to \$7,686,460. The department may continue or

35 18 served in shelter care that were implemented pursuant to 2008
